LEROY PITTMAN, affectionately called DaDa. was born on January 25, 1933 and was called from labor to reward on May 19, 2023. Leroy was 6th of 10 children born to Jesse and Blanche Pittman.

Leroy was educated in the Baltimore City Public School System. He played football for Paul Laurence Dunbar High School where he graduated in 1952. After graduating from Dunbar High School, he decided to join the navy where he served for 4 years. He was honorably discharged in August of 1960. Leroy then attended nursing school and then became a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN). Leroy served 34 years with the State of Maryland in the capacity. Working 7 years at Montibello State Hospital and 27 years with Clifton T. Perkins Hospital.

Leroy became a member of the Ancient Scottish Rite of Free Masonry in 1965 where he had risen from an apprentice to 32nd degree. He also served as a Worthy Patron for Order The Eastern Star. Leroy was a member of numerous social clubs such as the Five Plus One and noble Fellows.
