



## Leslie Cosby

November 19, 1933 - November 27, 2005

LESLIE LAWS COSBY, son of the late Leslie F. Cosby and Edith L. Cosby, was born in Baltimore, Maryland on November 19, 1933. He departed this life on November 27, 2005 after a lengthy illness. He received his education in the Baltimore City Public Schools and graduated from Dunbar High School in 1952. Leslie briefly attended the University of Maryland Eastern Shore on a music scholarship for playing the French Horn. While at the University he met and later married the late Gloria A. Cosby, and out of this union two children were born, Anthony and Kevin. Leslie served in the U.S. Air Force prior to his career in the U.S. Army where he served his country with pride and honor in Vietnam. While in the Army, Leslie received the Vietnam Service Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Good Conduct Medal and a Vietnam Campaign Medal. After his honorable discharge in 1969 he worked for the Federal Government as an Armed Security Officer and later as a Quality Assurance Specialist, both at Harry Diamond Laboratory in Adelphi, Maryland. Leslie had many other valuable careers before he was forced to retire to care for his ailing wife in 1994. Les, as he was affectionately known, was a proud man who loved to be around family and friends, and capture memorable moments on camera. He made numerous friends wherever he went and will be sincerely missed by everyone who knew him. He leaves to mourn: two sons, Anthony and Kevin Cosby; a sister, Edith Oswell; four grandchildren, LaTonya, Tavon, Kevin Jr. and Kameron; a nephew, Leslie Oswell; a brother-in-law, James A. Burley Jr.; a sister-in-law, June E. Burley; a daughter-in-law,

Jamaica Cosby; and a host of other relatives and friends.
