LETISHIA "TISH" (VAN) BARFIELD, founder of Barfield and Company Dance Studios died January 20, 2006. She is survived by her husband, Johnnie Barfield and her two daughters Sierra and Erica Barfield. Tish joined the Cluster Baptist Church in Aliceville, AL at an early age where she was extremely active in the Youth Choir as well as the Junior Missionary Society and the Junior Usher Board. She continued her service to God at Tabernacle Baptist Church in Chesterfield, VA., as an active member and as the director of the praise dance team. Her love for dance was evident at an early age by her passionate participation in dance activities highlighted by her selection as a Majorette for the Aliceville High School Marching Band and later as Pipette for Tuskegee University's Marching Crimson Piper Band. As an adult, Tish normally spent the vast majority of her days in front of a computer screen as an accountant with the Department of Juvenile Justice. However her passion and her heart still rested with dance. In 2001, Tish recruited 6 young ladies from the youth group at Trinity Baptist Church. In her mind, this small praise and dance group would promote the WORD by performing at local churches. Tish's vision culminated in the creation of Barfield and Company Dance Studios which at the time of her death had a company of high school and college-age dancers who performed at a variety of venues including Maymont and Paramount's Kings Dominion as well as Richmond's Cultural Arts Center. Tish's social activities included memberships in Wright Beauty 616 Chapter Order of the Eastern Star and the Delta Omega Chapter of Alpha

Kappa Alpha Sorority Inc. Letishia, we love you dearly and you will be greatly missed: Johnnie, loving and devoted husband; Erica and Sierra, loving daughters; Warren Lavender, father; and Belinda Lavender Windham (Terry), sister.

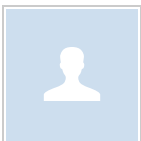
