Lillian Jane Campbell Jones (affectionately called Mimi by her family) was born August 21, 1924, the first of three children born to Dr. and Mrs. Emmett Campbell of Dayton, Ohio.

Following her graduation from Kiser High School, Lillian attended Howard University in Washington, D.C., then graduated from the University of Dayton in 1947. While pursuing graduate studies at Ohio State University in Columbus, Ohio, she met and subsequently married Dr. Thomas C. Jones on September 4, 1948. Together they had an active and close-knit family life with their four children.

Over the years, Lillian worked as an enumerator for the government and as a Dispensing Optician at her husband's office all the while caring for her family. She was also an active member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority. The Links Incorporated, Carats Incorporated, Jack and Jill of American, and the National Medical Association Auxiliary.

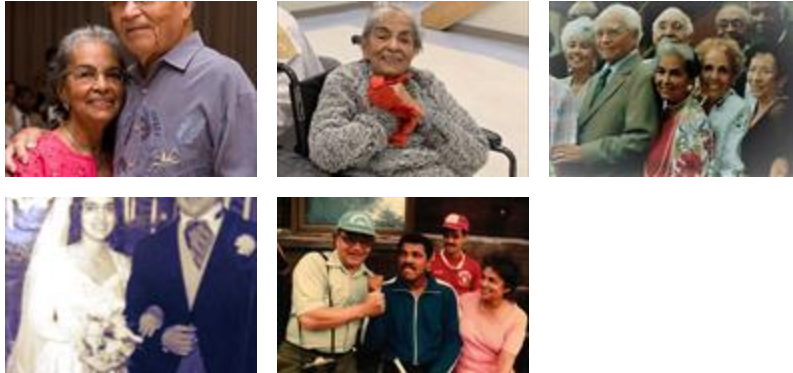
