LILLIAN MANERVIA PEYTON, AFFECTIONATELY KNOWN AS 'SIS', WAS BORN ON JUNE 9, 1928 TO THE LATE DANIEL AND LELIA JOHNSON IN WARRENTON, NC. SHE ENTERED INTO ETERNAL REST ON WEDNESDAY, JUNE 21, 2017 AT MEMORIAL REGIONAL HOSPITAL HOSPICE CARE. SHE WAS EDUCATED AT MCIVER HIGH SCHOOL IN LITTLETON, NC. UNTIL MOVING TO RICHMOND WHERE SHE CONTINUED HER EDUCATION AT ARMSTRONG HIGH SCHOOL. AT AN EARLY AGE SHE JOINED ZION HILL BAPTIST CHURCH IN LITTLETON, NC. ON NOVEMBER 25, 1948. SHE MARRIED ROSCOE PEYTON IN RICHMOND, VA. SIS WORKED FOR RICHMOND PUBLIC SCHOOLS 24 YEARS UNTIL SHE RETIRED JULY 1, 1990. SIS WAS EXCEPTIONAL AT COOKING SUNDAY DINNERS AND FEEDING EVERYONE THAT STOPPED BY. SHE ALWAYS REMEMBERED FAMILY MEMBER'S BIRTHDAYS AND YOU COULD COUNT ON GETTING A CHRISTMAS CARD FORM HER. SIS WAS PRECEDED IN DEATH BY HER HUSBAND, ROSCOE PEYTON; 3 BROTHERS, WILLIE, CLAUDE, AND LEON; 4 SISTERS, ROSA, BESSIE, HELENA AND MARGARET. 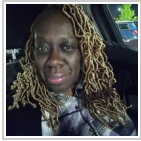
