A happy child with natural athletic abilities and a curious mind, LINARD GIBSON SR. was born on August 16, 1978, to Leon Gibson Jr. and Sandra Gibson in Baltimore, MD. Linard spent most of his preschool years in Wake Forest, North Carolina where he demonstrated his athletic skills almost immediately. In T-Ball, he could hit further; in soccer he was the strongest kicker, and, in every activity, he was consistently faster than his peers. He loved riding his bike.

Upon returning to Maryland, the family took up residence in Randallstown where Linard began his academic career in the Baltimore County Public School System. From 1992-1996, Linard attended and graduated from Randallstown High School. He was known as a popular student, a good friend to his close circle, and an avid sneaker aficionado.

After graduating from Randallstown High, Linard attended Morgan State University, earning a number of undergraduate credits while pursuing engineering as his career. It was at Morgan State that Linard met his best friend and the love of his life, Lisha Ford. They married on July 1, 2005.

affectionately known as LJ. He was constantly proud of every accomplishment and new milestone his children reached, all the way into their adulthood, and strove to be the best father he could.
