Linda Marie (Thompson) Sinkler was born on March 7, 1954 in Paterson, NJ. She was one of eight children born to the late Johnnie B. and Rosa Marie Thompson. Linda was educated in the Paterson Public Schools. She was a graduate of John F. Kennedy High School and also studied at Tombrook College in West Paterson, NJ.

At an early age, Linda confessed Christ as her personal savior, was baptized and became a member of the St. Luke Baptist Church of Paterson, NJ under the leadership of the late Rev. Dr. A.M. Tyler. Linda actively served and participated in the Life of the St. Luke Church throughout her entire life until she relocated to Richmond, VA in 2007. Upon her relocation to Virginia, Linda continued her Christian nurture, first uniting with the Fifth Street Baptist Church under the leadership of the Rev. F. She was later certified as MED Technician and was employed at Clara's Adult Home in Richmond, VA.

nonsense matriarch. Linda loved and valued her family and met everyone with a smile.
