Lloyd Joseph Glasper was born October 28, 1933 to Joseph Willard Washington, Sr. and Viola Glasper. After an ongoing battle with health-related illnesses, on Friday, October 25, 2019, Lloyd Joseph Glasper, Sr. peacefully passed away at Sinai Hospital.

He attended Douglass High School and graduated from college as a certified engineer. He retired after 35 years working as an engineer for the Baltimore City Jail.

Lloyd was a family man who lived life to the fullest. In 1959 he met and married the love of his life, Rosa Fields. To this date, they have been married 60 years. Not only did they share their love for each other for so many years, they also shared the same birth date, October 28th. From this union three children were born: Carol, Lloyd, Jr., and Lisa. As if three weren't enough, Lloyd frequently brought over his younger siblings to spend nights. In fact, he included them in his family dinner outings where he taught and demanded table manners. Often, Lloyd even included them in his family vacations - vacations his siblings would not have otherwise experienced during their childhood. Lloyd was a caring man who would visit his family in health, sickness, and death: in their home, hospital, or cemetery, respectively. Due to his passion for photography, the family could always count on Lloyd for capturing memories at family outings.

For more than 85 years, Lloyd was also loyal to his church family at Fulton Baptist - The Friendly Church on the Corner. There he served in various capacities: recorded weekly member contributions, assisted with quarterly financial reports, provided janitorial services, sang on the choir, and of course, given his hobby and gift, he was also the church's photographer. Lloyd continued serving his beloved place of worship until restricted by illness.

As an engineer, Lloyd stayed on the cutting edge of technology from video to audio devices and beyond. Lloyd never allowed his disability to hinder his technological growth. Even in his 80's, he read about and shopped on line for all sorts of modern electronic gadgets, and frequently checked his emails.

Lloyd Gasper was preceded in death by his children Carol Sheddric, Lloyd Joseph Gasper Jr., his great-grandson Marcel Wagstaff and three sisters Laretta Reid, Hattie Barnhill, Rose Ann White.
