LOIS M. COLE, daughter of the late Frank H. Kelly and Rosa Kelly, was born on February 12, 1926 in Baltimore, Maryland. She departed this life on July 6, 2020.

She received her education at Carver Vocational High School in Baltimore, Maryland graduating in June 1944. During high school, she worked several part time jobs until graduation. She then started working at Glen L. Martin Company full time as a time keeper for less than a year. Lois then started working at St. Agnes Hospital setting up instruments in the operating room for a short period of time. She finished up her career at Carr Lowery Glass Company and finally Maryland Glass Company where she was a packer and glass inspector for 25 years before retiring in January 1968.

Lois was a charter member of the Village Baptist Church and a member of the Faithful Seniors Organization serving as a treasurer for several years. She was a member of Friendship Baptist Church from 1960 until they moved in the late 1980's.

Lois married Charles E. Cole in May 1947 and from this union two children were born, Dorleen and Arvell. Lois was a kind and caring person who made friends wherever she went. She loved to play pinochle. She was in a club in Mt. Winans and remained a member after moving to Gwynn Avenue on June

25, 1957. She stopped playing in the 1960's because of transportation.

Lois was preceded in death by her husband, Charles; twin sister, Louise Brogdon and her sister, Doris Crawford.

Lois leaves to cherish her memory: daughter, Dorleen P. Allen (Ben); son, Arvell C.
