



## Louise Alexander

February 27, 1914 - December 22, 2013

LOUISE ALEXANDER, daughter of Peter Thomas Davis and Martha Ann Davis, was born on February 27, 1914 in Halifax County, North Carolina. Louise departed this life on December 22, 2013 after a short illness.

Louise attended Mt. Gilbert Elementary School. She completed her education at Dunbar High School night school.

Louise married Selisa Alexander on March 5th, 1932, and moved to Baltimore, MD in January 1935. She worked as a domestic for 50 years retiring in October 1984. Louise loved the Lord and faithfully read her Bible each morning and prayed to the Lord morning and night. She attended Emanuel Baptist Church under the leadership of Reverend Norfleet, her brother-in-law, until his death. She then joined and attended the Christian Community Church of God under the leadership of Elder Conway Greene from 1961 to 2003. In 2003 she joined the Providence Inspirational Baptist Church under the leadership of Rev. Clifton Freeman where she remained until her death.

Louise was the mother of seven children, four who preceded her in death, Levy Alexander, Floyd Alexander, Marie McGirt and Lucille Gorham. She leaves to mourn: three children, Charles C. Alexander, Lillian Singleton and Mardell Alexander; sixteen grandchildren, thirty-three great-grandchildren, a

host of nieces and nephews and great-great-grandchildren.
