Louise H. Robinson, daughter of Maude and Harvey Wright, was born January 30, 1931 in Glenside, Pennsylvania. She departed this world on January 14, 2005 to receive her eternal reward. Louise enjoyed her childhood amongst her parents, brother and sisters. At an early age, it was discovered that she had been blessed with the talent of singing. As the leader of a small gospel group, she performed on programs with legends such as the late Ward Singers and the late Mahalia Jackson. Great joy was obtained by her and others through her songs; and many concerts were performed by her through the years. She made one record during that time. Louise was joined in holy matrimony to Walter Robinson who was in the Marine Corp and eventually settled in East Orange, New Jersey. Out of this union were born LaVerne Robinson and Sophia Robinson. Eventually, Louise moved to Washington, D.C. with her two children, whom she cared for deeply. While in D.C., Louise became a member of Mount Carmel Baptist Church and was a Sunday school teacher for a period of time. After moving to Baltimore, she joined the New Psalmist Baptist Church. In her lifetime, Louise had various jobs, including Sales Agent for a Life Insurance Company while in Pennsylvania, Salad Preparer for Harvard University Medical School while living in Boston, Nursing Assistant in Pennsylvania and New Jersey, and a Governmental employee in Washington, D.C.; holding clerical positions in the Pentagon, Department of Agriculture and eventually receiving top secret clearance from the Government. In later years, Louise loved traveling the states while enjoying Evangelistic Crusaders, giving

encouragement to the sick and shut-in, especially visiting those in the nursing homes and hospitals, evangelizing, helping the needy, and above all, serving the Lord. Louise is survived by her daughters, LaVerne Robinson and Sophia Robinson, MD; a sister and scores of nieces and nephews. She was a lovely person and she will be greatly missed.
