He then was elected as Business Agent & Trustee for Teamsters Local # 355, where he served 20 years, and retired from the Teamsters in February, 1984. Lovely would be in front of the television anytime the wrestling match was on. He was a true friend and a devoted family man. He served as Chairman of the Deacon Board for many years, and he served as President of the Deacon's conference of Baltimore & Vicinity. He was an instructor of the Baptist Training Union, the Church School, Mann's Memorial Ministry (for over 50 years), and active member of Manpower Ministry until his health prevented him from attending the monthly prayer breakfast.
