LUCELIA SHIRLEY STARVIS HENDERSON, was born on March 21, 1916, in Northumberland County, Virginia, the youngest child of the late Deacon Aldophus and Lucelia Starvis. At an early age she accepted Christ and became a member of Shiloh Baptist Church, Burgess, Virginia under the leadership of Dr. Ellison and received early religious training.
