February 21, 1927 - January 14, 2003

Reverend Lucille Sarah Hall, daughter of the late Calvin Lyon and Sarah Lyon Dorsey, was born on February 21, 1927 in Washington, D.C. After a number of uncommon life experiences that spanned 75 years, Rev. Hall moved forward in the Circle of Life on January 14, 2003. Her Homegoing is celebrated by three daughters who have the blessed assurance that their mother now enjoys perfect health and peace in the loving Arms of the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. Rev. Hall often spoke of five significant events in her life: the day she was called by God to a life of service; the birth of each of her three daughters; and a night in 1951 when she preached her first sermon. Great joy accompanied each of these events. Rev. Hall retired from active ministry in 1993 but never lost the zeal and desire to win souls for her Lord. Rev. Hall married the former Jackson Samuel Hall of Washington, D.C. and this union produced three daughters: Linda Lucille Hall, Sheila Ann Hall, and Jacqueline Bernadette Hall Aguilar. Those who mourn Rev. Hall's passing and celebrate her life include three daughters and four grandchildren (James Gary Swinson, II; Jacqueline Amanda Aguilar; Paul Anthony Aguilar; and Michael Alexander Aguilar). She also leaves behind aunts, uncles, a sister-in-law; three brothers-in-law; a host of cousins, nieces and nephews; friends and neighbors at the Penn North Plaza senior citizens building; and those lives she touched through ministry. Rev. Lucille Hall was a woman of uncanny vision and spiritual aspiration. She relentlessly held the vision of her return to a life of full-time ministry and the help of her three daughters in spreading the Gospel

of Jesus Christ. Rev. Hall's daughters rejoice in the knowledge that their mother will forever live in the presence of Almighty God.
