Lucinda attended the public schools of Greensboro, North Carolina; however, due to a number of circumstances, she received most of her early education in the New York City public schools. Lucinda first marriage (to the late Luther W. Jackson) was blessed with a daughter, Rebecca, born in 1948. Unfortunately, that union ended in divorce, although they remained friends. She was married for a short time to John Solomon which ended in divorce.
