April 28, 1938 - December 23, 2014

Lucrecia M. Parker (nicknamed Patsy), age 76, transitioned on December 23, 2014. Patsy was born in San Andres (South America) on April 28, 1938, to parents Choyo Mitchell and Ina Archibald.
