



## Lucy Cozart

April 10, 1920 - November 30, 2023

LUCY (LOU) HENRIETTA THOMAS-COZART, daughter of the late Salmon and Ella Julia Thomas, was born in Abbeville, South Carolina on April 10, 1920. She departed this life on November 30, 2023.

Aunt Lou had eight siblings, Edith Ann Thomas-Finney, James, Marion, Jessie, Bell, Maggie, and Fannie Thomas whom all preceded her in death. Most recently, niece Chante Washington became her caregiver (who also preceded her in death).

Aunt Lou did not receive any formal education beyond grade school. At 18 years young, she moved to Baltimore where she met the love of her life, Hubert Nathaniel Cozart, affectionately known as Uncle Nat. He joined the military then asked for her hand in marriage, she said yes, and they then traveled the world. From this union they had a son, Jessie James who preceded them both in death.

Aunt Lou later became a foster parent for about nine youths who needed a home and guidance. Uncle Nat retired from the military and returned to Baltimore to join his wife and son. Embarking on new endeavors, Uncle Nat would be the opening act (tap dancing) at the Royal Theater for esteemed artists such as Pearl Bailey, Sammy Davis Jr., Redd Foxx, just to name a few; all the while it was exciting to be around so much talent, supporting her husband. Aunt Lou would say with a smile "That's my Nat".

Aunt Lou, a devout christian member of Highway Church of Christ, enjoyed belonging to organizations such as Eastern Star. She was known in her

neighborhood for years as the lady at 939 Northhill, who prepared food to feed anyone who needed a meal. She actually handed out plates from the door. She cooked holiday feasts that could feed an army, complete with signature cakes and pies. She loved nature and bird watching, dancing, music and had a grand sense of humor.

Aunt Lou leaves to cherish her memory: special nieces, Phyllis Thomas and Inell Thomas; oldest nephew, Daniel Thomas (Dannyboy); countless grand-neices and grand-nephews, family and friends.
