Luemisher Jordan was born to Mary and Charlie ("Buddy") Andrews on August 7, 1933 and lived with her parents and twelve (12) siblings in Lynchburg, South Carolina. She departed this life peacefully in her sleep on May 21, 2018, after a long illness.

She completed high school in South Carolina, and shortly thereafter moved to Baltimore, Maryland. There she received training as a nurse and worked at Johns Hopkins Hospital.

She married Oscar Jordan in 1958, and out of this union four (4) children were born; Roderick, Cynthia, Pamela, and Deborah. Later in life she raised her granddaughter, Brittany, as her daughter.

Luemisher and Oscar relocated to New York City in 1964. While teaching at a local elementary school, she attended night school at New York University, where she obtained her Associates Degree.

Luemisher joined St. Mary's Chapter #28 order of the Eastern Star and remained an active member for over 40 years. During that time, she worked diligently and achieved the office of Worthy Matron, the highest office in the Chapter. When St. Mary's Chapter submitted its charter to United Grand Chapter, she affiliated with Alpha Chapter #22 where she served as Financial

Secretary.

Luemisher served as Royal Matron of Azalea Court Number 3 R.E.D.A. for three (3) years; she served as Most Ancient Matron of Shoffar Court Number 2, H.O.J. for two (2) years. She served as Chief Counselor of Mt. Moriah Council Number 3, Lady Knights of Templar; as Most Worthy Grand Matron of Oleika Court #9, A.A.O.D.O.S. and was a member of Fredricka Palace, #1 Royal Ladies. Luemisher Jordan also served on the Board of Directors of United Grand Chapter for a number of years.

She was keenly interested in politics and was active in the Democratic Party.
