Lula B. "LB" Edmonds, daughter of the late Randolph and Hattie S. James, was born on February 11th, 1924 in Northampton County, North Carolina. She departed this life on April 23, 2015 after a lengthy illness.

LB received her education in the public school system in North Carolina. She married the late Willie Sr., in 1950, and they moved to Baltimore in 1954. While raising her family, she volunteered as a substitute teacher at Elementary School #141 in West Baltimore. She was employed for a brief time at Trailways Bus Company, worked for the Hecht Company, and as a short order cook. She was a faithful member of the First Baptist Church of Fairfield.
