MR. LYNLADE SAMUEL GORDON, son of the late Benjamin Gordon and Sarah Turner, was born on July 4, 1940 in Manchester, Jamaica. He was educated in St. Mary, Jamaica where he studied carpentry. From 1963 to 1970 he worked as a proud orthopedic technician at the University of West Indies. He migrated to the United States in 1970 and settled in Baltimore, Maryland where he took the city by storm. His dependable outgoing personality immediately landed him a successful career at Union Memorial Hospital where he was employed for twenty years. His professional years continued at the Children's Hospital for yet another twenty-one years until he retired July 2014.

He was a dearly loved and time-honored member of Grace Presbyterian Church since 1980. Lynlade was also a highly respected pioneer of the Jamaican Association of Maryland and was an active participant for over 20 years. He could be seen dancing the night away and was known around town as the life of the party. Also known as Mr. Big, he cruised around town blasting
