June 13, 1944 - April 22, 2020

Mrs. Mable Lynn Hervey Carthon-Johnson passed away at Future Care of Chesapeake in Arnold, Maryland on April 22, 2020 at the age of 75. She was born on June 13, 1944 in Water Valley, Mississippi and was the oldest child to parents Ned and Mable Alexander Hervey. She graduated from Davison High School and lived on her parents' farm until she married Edward Carthon on March 22nd, 1964.

During their marriage, she and her husband raised two daughters Kathy and Sharon while traveling with the military and finally making their home in Gambrills, Maryland.

Mable held various jobs through the years, but her absolute favorite was being a bus driver for Avis at BWI Airport. Where she was able to meet many celebrities such as Phyllis Hyman. 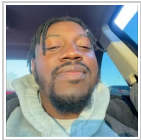

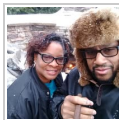
