MacKenzie Lauren Taylor was born on November 21, 2001, in Baltimore, Maryland, the beloved only child of Broderick Taylor and Timi Roberts. On the evening of Wednesday, June 11, 2025, MacKenzie departed this life after a brief and sudden illness.

MacKenzie was born with a rare genetic disorder called Prader-Willi Syndrome. While this condition presents many physical and intellectual challenges, anyone who knew MacKenzie knew right away that she was sharp. She surpassed milestone that doctors once thought were out of reach. Her strength, drive and her determination were nothing short of extraordinary. Despite ongoing health challenges and frequent hospital stays, MacKenzie kept pushing forward. She proudly graduated from Randallstown High School in 2020- a moment of deep pride for her, her family and her entire village. MacKenzie was confident, persuasive and deeply self-aware. MacKenzie knew how to advocate for herself, and she never settled for less than what she needed or deserved. By her side through it all was her devoted mother, Timi, and a loving community of family and friends who stood firmly behind her.

Her father, Broderick, was a constant presence- always just a phone call away. His emotional and financial support never wavered. MacKenzie and Timi both knew they could count on him, without questions.

She shared a special bond with her Nana, Jeannie, who played a vital role in her life, not only as a grandmother, but as her co-caregiver. Nana eventually retired so she could be there for MacKenzie full time; a selfless act of love and devotion that meant the world to them both.

Together this circle of love made it possible for Mackenzie to pursue her dreams that she reached through faith, courage and heart full of hope.

MacKenzie was a joyful, witty and loving young lady. Her laughter could light up the room. She loved reading, music, movies, playing cards, board games and collecting plush animals.

She especially adored animals, none more than Charlie, the beloved dog of her cousins, Kira and Makayla. MacKenzie looked forward to belly rubs and photo updates and special visits to Aunt Terri's house just to spend time with him.

MacKenzie was especially close to her cousins, Omari, with whom she shared many laughs, conversations and cherished times.

MacKenzie loved Aunt Vickie, they often spent time together researching foods for her special diet and chatting about health and wellness. She had a generous and affectionate spirit. She filled her days with the things that brought her joy like shopping trips, bookstore visits, library stops, and her signature Target and Walmart runs, and of course, online shopping, Mac was a pro.

Perhaps the most beautiful chapter of MacKenzie's life was extraordinary bond she shared with her mother, Timi. They weren't just mother and daughter, they were soulmates, kindred spirits. Their love was deep,

unwavering and full of grace. Her strength, presence and her steadfast love made Timi MacKenzie's greatest hero.

MacKenzie was preceded in death by Aunt's Tammy Ranson and Victoria Taylor- Wilson, one Uncle Andre Spriggs, a beloved Grandmother Mildred Walker, her Grandfather Henry Roberts and Great- grandmother, Gertrude Dillie Booth.

MacKenzie is lovingly remembered by her devoted parents, Timi Roberts and Broderick Taylor; her beloved grandmother and co-caregiver, Gloria Booth (Nana); godmother, Audrey Quarles; and dear friend, Roslyn Garner, who provided respite care and companionship throughout MacKenzie's life. 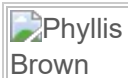
