She was on the Westinghouse bowling team and birthday club with her friends. She loved to set up vacations and cruises for family

members and friends. God granted her hearts desire as she won two show cases on her favorite television program "The Price Is Right."She will be remembered for her elegance and style, also her famous sweet potato casserole, home made baked goods and her macaroni and cheese!She leaves to cherish her memory: her devoted husband, Elder Robert Braggs; her children, Geraldine Osborne, Gloria Howell, Debra Robinson, Cortez Glenn and Brenda Day; son, Bernard Glenn, who preceded her in death; sister, Pastor E.
