November 10, 1928 - December 4, 2001

Mae Frances Ringgold, daughter of Alice Johnson Ebron and the late James Ebron, was born on November 10, 1928, in Baltimore, Maryland. She departed this life on Tuesday, December 4, 2001. She received her education at Harvey Johnson Junior High. In her adult life Mae worked for Baltimore city Public Schools at Cherry Hill Junior High # 180 (now Arnette Brown Middle School). She was widely known for her community activities; serving as President for the Sharp & Leadenhall Pack for several years, coordinating and managing the Southside Stompers marching band, helping her neighbors acquire affordable housing through Light Street Housing, working with the local Police Athletic League (PAL) Center; as well as other community related organizations. She also played a big part in organizing Solo Gibbs Day every year. Mae Frances was affectionately known as the “Mayor” of South Baltimore, referring to everyone as “Little Girl” or “Little Boy”, no matter how old they were. She was an advocate for keeping the neighborhood streets clean, soliciting the neighborhood children to participate in the cleaning and assuring that the City supplied the necessary equipment. She constantly monitored the City Council meeting to be sure to preserve the South Baltimore neighborhood as best she could. She leaves to cherish her memories: her devoted mother, Alice Ebron; one sister, Dorothy Moore; one aunt, Viola Rawlings; three sons, Craig L. Ringgold; Kenneth W. Ringgold and Juan R. Ebron; her eldest son, Donnell Ringgold preceded her in death; two daughters, Natasha A. Ringgold and Jacqueline A. Jones; one son-in-law,

Lewis Jones; one daughter-in-law, Sharon Ebron; eighteen grandchildren, twelve great-grandchildren; and a host other relatives and friends.
