Mae Lucille Hardy entered into eternal peace on Monday, May 28, 2018 at The House Of Grace Assisted Living after 99 years of life. She was the third of eight children born to the late James Argent Jackson and Mary Gertrude Jackson on February 4, 1919 in Anne Arundel County, Maryland.

Mae received her education in Anne Arundel County Public Schools. She married the late Reverend Albert J. Hardy early in life and was married for many years. They founded the New Baptist church in the early 1960s and presided over the church for decades. Mae was the First Lady, missionary, and on the trustee board.

She was an excellent cook and enjoyed spending time in her garden. She loved to laugh and had a wonderful sense of humor. She also enjoyed playing Pinochle with her friends and sisters. Later in life, Mae contracted Alzheimer disease and, for the past 16 years, resided at The House Of Grace Assisted Living with owner and operators, Anne and Carl Jones. 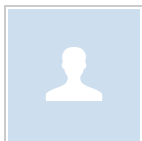
