Mae received her educational background in the Hoke County School System and later attended high school in Fayetteville, North Carolina. After leaving school, Mae worked at the Silver Grill Café in Fayetteville, North Carolina. In 1956, Mae and Eugene Owens were joined in marriage and later moved to Baltimore, Maryland in 1958. To this union five sons were born.

At a young age, Mae accepted Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior. Upon moving to Baltimore, Mae was a long time member of New Union Baptist Church, until she was unable to attend due to health issues. Mae worked several jobs including the Greyhound Bus Company, Social Security Administration and The Eatery. In 1989, Mae retired. a young age, shopping and traveling along with completing crossword puzzles and having long conversations with her grandchildren.
