Maisie (Horsey) Moody the daughter of the late Maisie Evans and Howard Horsey born Oct. 11, 1931 in Baltimore, Md. Maisie departed this life when an angel of mercy sent by God came on Friday morning May 15, 2020 with her wings and took her home. Affectionately known as Granny to her family, friends and neighbors in the Cherry Hill Community. Maisie was a kind, loving and devoted mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, great -great- grand mother, sister, aunt and friend. Maisie's favorite saying was I have more children than I birthed, and I love them all.

Maisie attended Baltimore City Public Schools, and later worked many years in the Baltimore City School System as a Custodial Engineer. She was well loved by the staff and the children. Maisie had a personal relationship with her Lord and Savior and was a member of the First Baptist Church of Cherry Hill since the 1950s. She was a social butterfly even though she didn't go out a lot. She was easy to talk to because of her outgoing personality and friendliness even to strangers. She was very independent and never wanted to be a bother to anyone. She just wanted to help everyone. If you gave her something or did something for her she always wanted to pay you and would get feisty about it if you refused to accept payment. Maisie loved her community and was well known in the Cherry Hill Community where she had lived for 67 yrs.

Even though Maisie only had three biological children, she was called "Granny" by almost everyone because she shared her love and affection to all the community kids, so to them she was their Granny too.

She was preceded in death by her daughters Aretha, & Mildred (Minnie) and her siblings Dorothy, Ben and Howard Jr. close friends (Shirley, Agnes, Louise)

She leaves to Cherish her memory, her sister Bernice, her son Pete and his wife Ann. 4 grandsons Kevin (Sharise), Keith (Loren), Korey (Tonia), and Wade. 2 grand daughters Terracita & Nakisha, 20 great grand and 7 great-great grand. Special nieces Cassandra, Cookie, Cheryl and Jackie.
