July 21, 1928 - November 28, 2014

On November 28, 2014, the angels came down and peacefully carried SR. MAJELLA NEALE home. Since she gave her life to Christ at an early age, Sr. Majella guaranteed her soul's admittance to a place of eternal rest.

She was born Julia Neale in Baltimore, Maryland on July 21, 1928 to the late Samuel and Henrietta Curtis Neale. She started her life in Christ with Baptism at St. Peter Claver Church.

Sr. Majella received her education at St. Peter Claver Elementary School, St. Frances Academy High School, Loyola and Notre Dame colleges, and Peabody Institute of Music. She ultimately received her Master's Degree from Notre Dame College.

She entered the community of The Oblate Sisters of Providence on September 8, 1949, a year after graduating from high school and took the name Sr. Mary Majella, honoring her second grade teacher's wishes, Sr. Majella.

Sr. Majella was a teacher, school principal, sacristan, musician, and a minister of prayer. She served in various locations as an educator such as - Baltimore, Ridge, Maryland, Miami, Florida, Aiken, South Carolina, New Orleans, Louisiana, and Minneapolis, Minnesota.

She was loved and admired by her students.

She leaves to mourn: sisters, Isabelle Neale and Catherine N. Thomas; many nieces and nephews, and a host of other relatives and friends.
