Marcia Maria Maith, born on February 13, 1950, in Baltimore, Maryland, to the late Grace Elizabeth Norton and Isaiah Maith, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, September 11, 2024, after a courageous battle with heart failure. She was 74 years old. Marcia was the second oldest of her siblings, and she was preceded in death by her brothers Gregory Norton, Ishmale Ashburn, Renard Maith, and her nephew William Maith.

Marcia received her formal education in the Catholic school system before graduating from Cortez W. Peters Business School in Baltimore with the guidance and support of her loving mother. Marcia's drive for success continued as she earned her bachelor's degree in business management from the College of Notre Dame and became a proud graduate of Cannon Trust School. She went on to have a distinguished career in finance, retiring from M&T Bank and Trust as a Vice President and Senior Portfolio Manager after more than 30 years of dedicated service. Prior to that, she held the position of Senior Vice President with Allfirst Trust Company. Her achievements earned her recognition as one of Baltimore's Top 100 Women in 2005.

Marcia was not only a remarkable professional but also a committed servant to her community and church. She was actively involved in the National Chapter of the American Heart Association, the Maryland Mentoring Partnership, and the Maryland Committee for Children. Even in retirement, Marcia continued to contribute as a consultant for Counsel Trust Company of York, PA.

Marcia was known for her radiant spirit, infectious humor, and ability to make everyone feel like family. Her love of life was exemplified through her adventures with her beloved husband, John D. Glover, Jr., whom she married on June 26, 1992. Together, they filled their days with joy, laughter, and friendships—whether organizing bus trips, traveling, or hosting their famous New Year's trips.

Marcia's devotion to her faith was profound. As a dedicated member of Resurrection Fellowship Church in Shrewsbury, PA, she served as the church's financial advisor and became a spiritual warrior who inspired her fellow members through her leadership and love.

Marcia's memory will be cherished by her daughter, Shawnel "Shawnie" Cloud; her devoted husband, John D.
