MARGARET ELEANOR PAGE was born in Catonsville, Maryland where she lived for many years and attended Baltimore County Schools. She worked for Dr. William McGrath as a housekeeper, and later worked at Spring Grove State Hospital as a Nursing Assistant until she retired. She was a member of Morning Star Baptist Church for several years. In the early 1950's she dedicated her life as a Jehovah Witness and was a faithful and longtime member. She became a pioneer in the organization serving Jehovah in her Edmondson Village neighborhood. She continued to share Jehovah's words of love and His Kingdom with everyone she came in contact with until her illness. Margaret enjoyed attending her weekly meetings at the Kingdom Hall, and truly enjoyed the Jehovah Witness Conventions. She went as far as Hawaii to the conventions with many of her friends in the organization. In 1943 she married Carlton Jacob Page. The couple had two children, Barbara and David. Another daughter, Jean M. Groomes, preceded her in death. Her husband died in 1987. Surviving are a daughter, Barbara; a son, David; sister, Annie Gaither of Pennsylvania; three dedicated sisters-in-law, Eva Brooks, Mary Manokey and Nettie Page and other in-laws; thirteen grandchildren, several great-grandchildren; many nieces, great-nieces, -nephews, and her Jehovah Witness Family.
