



## Margaret R. Adams

September 8, 1919 - November 21, 2004

Margaret R. Adams, a longtime resident of Turners Station, died on November 21, 2004 at the age of eighty-five of a heart attack at her home at 125 Balnew Avenue. She was known fondly as “Aunt Margaret” by her nieces and nephews and “Sister” by her three brothers. Aunt Margaret did not have any children of her own, but she was loved by three generations of children of family and friends—always willing to give them more than she would ever receive. On holidays, she prepared large amounts of food and never turned anyone away from her kitchen. Aunt Margaret also loved animals. Once she had a talking bird and seven stray dogs. When she was a youngster, she had a pet pig named “Whitney” and a three-legged dog. Her favorite television shows were on the animal channel and the only animals she did not like were snakes and reptiles. Aunt Margaret was born on September 8, 1919 in Turners Station. Until her death, she was the last surviving member of her family which included her father, Irvin; mother, Emma and three brothers, John, Clarence and William. Aunt Margaret met many famous entertainers at her father’s bar, Adams Cocktail Lounge. Cab Calloway, Billie Holiday, the Ink Spots, Count Basie, Chick Webb were among them. Early in Pearl Bailey’s career, she was a regular singer at the bar, and she and Aunt Margaret became close friends. Aunt Margaret loved the house at 125 Balnew Avenue and in her later years did not venture far from it. She said there is no other place she’d rather live than Turners Station. “This has always been a wonderful community; the people are nice, the community is safe, it is still a beautiful community, plus I

still have many friends who reside her," she said.
