Marian L. Fletcher was born September 2, 1924 in Savannah, Georgia. She lived her life as a servant of the Lord. On January 24, 2019, while she slept peacefully, an angel of the Lord came by, took her hand and led her home to her Father in heaven.

Marian believed in Jesus Christ at the age of five years old. She was baptized sometime later in Mount Bethel Baptist Church in Daytona Beach, Florida where she became a member and remained a member until she moved to Baltimore. She remained an active worker of the church most of her life.

Marian married her childhood sweetheart, Joe Albert Lane. Two children were born to that union, Betty Jean and Kenneth Eugene. Joe and Betty Jean preceded Marian in death. home. While doing all of the above, Marian worked with Preach-It-Ministries doing field evangelism. She also completed the Evangelism Course of Study with

United Baptist Missionaries and Auxiliaries of Maryland, Inc. Marian continued teaching Sunday School and young neighborhood children in the Bible Club until she was unable to stand for long periods of time.
