Marilyn had a caregiver's heart. She was an awesome cook, known for her cakes and macaroni and cheese. She was a loving daughter, sister, aunt, niece, and friend. She was a breast cancer survivor. And she loved staying in contact with family near and far.

Marilyn accepted Jesus Christ as her Savior at the age of 9 and was baptized at her home church, Baptist Liberty Baptist Church, in King William, VA.

Marilyn received her formal education in the King William County Public Schools. She furthered her education and obtained her bachelor's degree in Business from St. Paul's College in Lawrenceville, VA.

Her professional career included employment with Virginia Power, Union Theological Seminary, St. Phillip's Episcopal Church, and the Samuel Dewitt Proctor School of Theology at Virginia Union University. She was also a dedicated and dependable home health care provider.
