October 31, 1928 - October 15, 2005

MARION RINGGOLD, daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Clarence Holiday, was born on October 31, 1928, in Baltimore, Maryland. She went home to be with the Lord on Saturday, October 15, 2005 after a brief illness. She received her education through the Baltimore City Public School System. Following her education, she married the late Morris H. Ringgold. Marion committed her life to God in 1983, and received the Gift of the Holy Ghost not many days after that. She became and remained a faithful member of the United Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ under the pastorate of Bishop James L. Hickey. Mother Ringgold, as she was affectionately known, was a Mother in Zion, a member of the Usher Board, and a faithful member of the Pastor's Aid Committee. Mother Ringgold also served as the Pastor's armour bearer. She was devoted in her service to God and demonstrated this through her committed service in unlocking the doors for service, ensured the temperature setting was comfortable, maintained the physical beauty of the sanctuary by tidying up, placing flowers and other items that helped to beautify the church. She received her certificate for leadership cell ministry on March 16, 2002. Although Mother Ringgold was small in stature, she had the heart of a giant for loving her children, grandchildren, friends and everyone. She will be sincerely missed by all who were blessed to know her. Her smile was a beacon of light to all and will continue to shine in our hearts. She leaves to mourn: eight daughters, Marie, Palestine, Marsha, Mary, Marlene, Robin, Sheila and Helen (who preceded her in death); three sons, Morris, Leonard
