Marjorie was a Golden Life Member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority Incorporated, the National League of Nursing, Sigma Theta Tau-National Honorary Nursing Sorority, and the Hampton University Alumni Association.

Attention to detail was one of her greatest abilities. And if you knew my mom, she had no problem conveying your shortcomings in that area. Even in her final days leading to her transition, my mom proved on several occasions, that she continued to possess that ability. An Administrator who remembered my mom, from St. Mary's heard about a patient giving a staff member a poignant critique. Hearing about this, she went to her room because it sounded familiar. She immediately recognized who it was. Her advice was to do what my mom said and take some notes along the way. You just may learn something.

Marjorie was preceded in death by her husband, Booker; brother, William Jr., and a sister, Vivian. She leaves to treasure her memories two sons, Gordon and Fred; only grandchild, Lana; brother, Richard Jr.; sister-in-law, Julia; a very special friend, Robin; a host of other family and close friends.
