April 12, 1948 - November 3, 2017

Marjorie Diana Taylor was born in Alberta Virginia on April 12th 1948 to Katherine Carrington Graves and Johnnie Mac Graves. She was the seventh of nine; 5 boys & 4 girls. Marjorie was baptized at Oak Grove Baptist Church around age 10. She attended Public School at Brooks Elementary School through the 5th grade. Marjorie then attended Oak Grove Elementary through grade 7. She would complete her primary education at James Solomon Russell High School in 1966. Marjorie also attended classes at Coppin State University nursing program in 1978.

As a young adult Marjorie would visit Baltimore often where she met the love of her life Thomas James Irick Taylor. In 1967 Marjorie and Thomas were joined in Union and together they would welcome their baby girl Aundrea Lynn Taylor to the family.

Margie (as she was lovingly called) was a strong, resilient, independent and determined black woman with the pride and passion most wish for. She spent the greater part of her adult life advocating for the rights of employees in the healthcare industry. Margie would carry the torch like no other. Her passion would lead her to begin a career as a union representative for district 1199E at Sinai Hospital in 1982. This is where Margie found her true purpose. She will go on to move up the Strategic unionized ladder where she's held several offices including Executive Secretary for the Vice President of The National Union of Hospital and Health Care Employees for what's now known as District 1199 SEIU. In the latter half of Margie's career her passion shifted to

include working with the elderly, which prompted her to continue her education by obtaining certifications as GNA/CNA. This would lead her to becoming the president of the retirees division of 1199 SEIU in a voluntary capacity, which is the position she held until her untimely death.

As you all know Margie would not back down from a fight which made her well known by BCPD. She's been known to take one for the team. There wasn't a picket line she wouldn't stand in. Marjorie was not only passionate about her career but she was passionate about her family and the importance of togetherness. Her family meant everything to her. She was also the business manager of TGs our family group. Margie was passionate about keeping her parents Legacy strong and viable.
