Mary Lou Jefferys, was born on September 1, 1934 to the late Doctor and Elnora Kizzie in South Hill, Virginia. Her sisters were her very best friends; she loved her husband “Papa Smurf” (as she affectionately called him), her children, and all of her grandchildren. Emerie, her great-grandson, held a special place in her heart.
