September 17, 1910 - July 27, 2010

Mary Frances Muir was one of three children born on September 17, 1910, to the late Annie and Zadok Jones in Baltimore, Maryland. God sent his angel whose gentle hands sweetly carried Mary home to glory on the morning of July 27, 2010 at the age of ninety-nine.

Mary received her education at Frederick Douglass High School in Baltimore, Maryland where she excelled in Latin, typing and short hand. A few years later Mary met and married the late Howard J. Muir of Oriole, Maryland, and from this union they had one loving and devoted daughter, H. Sandra Yorkshire.

Mary loved the Lord and accepted Jesus as her personal savior early on in her life. She was an active member at Emmanuel Christian Community Church for most of her life, where she enjoyed singing her favorite songs on the choir, especially "How Great Thou Art." Mary also loved listening to the word of God and taking scriptural notes during church services.

Mary was what you would consider an independent woman, she enjoyed spending time with family, but was especially proud that she could live on her own until the age of ninety-nine. Her favorite pastime was playing the piano, singing, sewing and reading. You could enter her home and find news headlines all round. Mary was especially excited that she lived to see the first African American president.

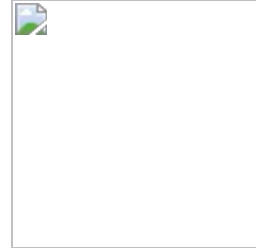
