MARY L. WATSON, was born in Columbia, Alabama on February 27, 1916. Mary was the fourth daughter of seven girls whose parents were the late Hughie and Olivia Henderson Granger. In the 1930's the family relocated to Baltimore, Maryland. She was a product of the Baltimore City Public School System. She also attended Morgan State College.

In 1940 Mary moved to Washington, D.C. where she was employed at the Pentagon as a Secretary for three years. She later attended Madam C.J. Walker Beauty School and eventually became the owner of three prominent beauty salons. She was married to the late John Watson, a Mortician in 1949. During this union she became a licensed Funeral Director. During her days as a beautician she was an active member of the National Beauty Culturist's League, Inc. Mary became interested in real estate, later becoming an agent, broker and formed her own company. Mary's business ultimately became a million dollar one. Being socially inclined, Mary opened a community residential facility, housing seniors and the disabled. She was involved in this business until retiring in 1994.

Mary accepted Christ as her personal Savior and attended the Leadenhall Baptist Church as a child and young adult. She continued her Christian walk at the Metropolitan Baptist Church in D.C.

She loved to sew and enjoyed entertaining family and friends. Because she had no children of her own, her nieces and nephews were her pride and joy: nieces, Faye, Rita, Brenda, Michon and Roslyn; nephews, the late Norman Brailey and the late Curtis C. Johnson. She entertained them at her summer home in Waldorf, Maryland and was always interested in their educational process.
