Matthew Okwuchukwu Enekwe son of the late Alfred and Catherine Enekwe was born May 2, 1943 in Port Harcourt, Nigeria (Capital of River state). He departed this life on the 26th day of February 2005 after a brief illness. He received his education at Metropolitan College in Anambra State and became a naval officer serving in the Biafran War.
