



## Mattie B. Naylor

December 6, 1920 - May 14, 2002

On Tuesday, May 14, 2002, Mattie Bell Naylor departed this life at 1:00 p.m. at St. Agnes Hospital after a lengthy illness. Mattie was born on December 6, 1920, the eleventh of thirteen children born to Mattie and Thomas Fletcher of Cordial, Georgia. Mattie was raised and educated in Baltimore, Maryland. During her youth, she accepted Christ Jesus as her personal Savior and was baptized. She attended Pennsylvania Avenue A.M.E. Zion Church. Later she transferred her membership to United Methodist Church of Wildwood Parkway, where she was an active member of the usher board until her illness. She was married and widowed at an early age. No children resulted from that union, but later in life she bore one child, Rosa, who died shortly after birth. She unselfishly devoted her life to help raise her sister's children, Vickie, Alvin and Michael, as a second Mom. Mattie loved to cook and entertain. Her favorite dish was steamed crabs. She was a woman of great substance whose quick wit could catch you off guard. Everyone knew and loved her as "Aunt Mattie." She listened, was nonjudgmental and very giving to those who sought her counsel. Mattie worked for many years as a domestic worker. Known for her cooking skills, she became a cook for the Frederick Villa Nursing Home. She retired in 1984. She leaves to mourn: her two sisters, Elizabeth and Janie Mae, and one brother, Robert Lee; three nieces, Victoria, Brenda and Teresa, and two nephews, Alvin and Michael; grand nieces, Jessica, Jevette, Octavia and LaTonya and nephew, Michael Paul; a host of great-grand nieces, nephews and friends.
