MATTIE BERNICE LITTLE (born Mattie Bernice Sellers) was born to Augustine King sellers Sr. (1884 – 1968) and his wife Mary Bivens Sellers (1892 – 1964), on September 30, 1928 in Wadesboro, North Carolina. She was called home to her reward on Tuesday, September 16, 2014. With her at the time of her passing was her son, GT Little, Jr.; daughter, Rochelle Dionne Little; nephew, A. Clinton Sellers, Sr. and his wife, Eleanor JoAnne Sellers.

Bernice was educated in the public schools of Anson County, North Carolina and enrolled at Fayetteville State Teacher's College. After graduation she became an elementary school teacher in Fayetteville, North Carolina. But at age 23, she relocated to Baltimore, Maryland to marry her sweetheart Gardner Thomas Little, Sr. on April 12, 1952. they remained together happily for 46 years until Gardner's passing in 1998. during that period they had two children, Gardner Thomas Little, Jr. (GT) and Rochelle Dionne Little. She did her graduate work at Coppin State Teacher's college earning her Master's in Education in 1970.

Bernice taught elementary school, 4th and 5th grade level Special Education students for more than thirty five years, turning down offers of becoming a Principal on several occasions. She though being an administrator was too far away from the action of actually molding a child's development and she was passionate about putting kids, whatever their disabilities, on the the right path

for successful adulthood. She was an avid gardener and she loved to travel.
