Maurice Cey Jones was born on September 6, 1977, the third son of Calvin and Roslyn Jones. Maurice was an inquisitive child with a quiet demeanor, a winning smile and an infectious laugh. He always did things his own way and was determined to find ingenious methods to achieve his plans. With an insatiable appetite and six siblings, he understood the importance of claiming food before it was gone. He earned the nickname "Piggy" because he was famous for sticking his finger into a plate of food so nobody else would want to eat it.

Maurice was in The National Academy of Finance program and graduated as salutatorian from Lake Clifton High School. He shined in the classroom and also on the field. His athletic earned him the position of Captain of the football team, where he was affectionately known as "Black" to his teammates.

At Morgan State University, Maurice majored in Business and Finance because he had such a love for numbers. His favorite number was three, but he also loved watching the numbers in his bank account increase. He was a hard worker and always found ways to earn extra income. During his college years, he charged twenty dollars to type up term papers for classmates and as an adult, he quickly became everyone's favorite tax guy.
