Harry. She was the proud grandmother of Julianna Marisol and Nyla Christina Harry. She leaves one brother, Dr. Larry T.

Johnson; two nephews, one niece; a special aunt, Mrs. Edith O. Turner; several cherished cousins, and a host of friends. She will be sorely missed by many.
