MAZERLENE VELOCK CALLOWAY was born May 13th, ~ 1930 to the late Joseph and Ader Pridgen in Columbus County, North Carolina. She departed this life on October 1st, 2014 at Sinai Hospital after a short illness at the age of 84. She attended Mt. Olive High School in North Carolina until she left to go to Baltimore. There she found a love for sewing while attending Douglass high School. Early in her career She did domestic work and was later employed at Misty Harbor for 18 years as a Seamstress before she retired. She grew her own vegetables, cared for plants and animals, and she never missed her daytime TV shows.

Mazerlene accepted Christ and was baptized at a young age. at Mt. Olive Baptist Church in North Carolina. She became a member of Gillis Memorial Community Church in Baltimore, Maryland. There she was a member of the Sanctuary Choir, the Good Neighbor's Auxiliary, Deaconess Board, and Bible study.

"V" or Velock, as she was often lovingly called, made a huge impact on everyone's life that she came in contact with, she had no problem expressing how she felt, and she was often looked upon as a second mother.

Her husband of sixty-two years, Willie Calloway, preceded her in death. From their union they had six children, Leutricia, Catherine (who both preceded her in death), Aida, Jeanette, Shirley, and Winston. She was also blessed with seven grandchildren, Angela, David Jr., Justin, Brittany, Alexander, Christopher, and Joseph, and one son-in-law, John Carter. Velock grew up

with five brothers, William and Vincent (who preceded her in death), David, Herman, Randolph and three sisters (who preceded her in death), Ida Mae, Elsie and Margret. She also leaves: two sisters- in-law; Arbena Pridgen and Rosa Terry; one brother-in-law, Willie Henry Alford, and a host of nieces, nephews, and cousins.
