He attended Ken bridge Virginia public schools and graduating from high school he journeyed to Baltimore, Maryland where he worked as a supervisor at Coca Cola. during his spare time he volunteered as at substitute teacher at St. James and John Catholic School. He later became a driver for the Omni Eye Service and worked part-time at March Funeral Home.

In 1968, Mac met Jennie Williams at Jerusalem Baptist Church, where he often said "her beautiful voice captured me." They were married on July 1, 1972 at his sister and brother-in-law's house and he made a vow that he would love her until the end of time.
