She baked, cooked, canned, made delicious pies, cakes, jellies, canned food from Winston's vegetable garden and tended her lovely flower garden. She passed seventeen happy, active, productive years with a God sent angel, Winston L. Bower, whom she called "Lovey Darling." Lovey Darling gave her attentive, loving care all those years and stayed by her bedside night and day

during her painful, debilitating, devastating short bout with cancer. Melinda fought a good, courageous fight with cancer got closer to God and relied on the blood of Jesus. She departed this life at 4:45 a.m. on Wednesday, December 3, 2003.
