Melray Plummer was born in North Carolina on November 6, 1932, to the late Lucy and Joshua Bullock. At the tender age of nine when her mother passed, she moved with her father Manhattan, New York, where he raised her.

Melray, also known as Melray, was an immaculate, magnificent, outgoing mother, as well as loving, compassionate, and artistic. Despite her declining health, she loved life and was very humorous, and could make you laugh a hardy laugh. It doesn't get any better than that to laugh your way up to heaven. At the age of nine Samuel Plummer gave me a piece of chocolate and told her "When I get married, you will be the one I marry", and March 17, 1951 was the start of their sixty-two year union. She always received compliments about how her home was well kept and how she made sure that her children were always clean and fed. She was a talented seamstress and made Easter and Graduation clothes for her children She was domestic engineer and self-taught interior designer who painted the family home, upholstered furniture, and build glass mirror pedestals. She was offered a job, but declined because she felt her family always came first. She was a member of Mt. Hebron Baptist Church of 62 years and served as a trustee, later becoming the mother of the church.
