Life Reflections

Deacon Melvin E. Crawford, 66, of Highland Springs, VA (formerly of Richmond, VA), lovingly called “Pop”, was born to Melvin E. Crawford, Sr. and Cleo V. Crawford on February 8, 1958. He gained his wings on August 2, 2024, surrounded by his beautiful wife, sons, daughters and prayer warriors at his side.

Melvin loved the Lord and accepted Jesus Christ joining New Elam Baptist Church in New Kent, Virginia. He was called to serve as a deacon, ordained May of 2015. He also served as Chairman of The Deacon for New Elam Baptist Church. Deacon Crawford was a humble servant of God. He was a living testament, not allowing the rocks to cry out in his place. Deacon Crawford seized every opportunity to give his praise to God.

Deacon Crawford was educated in the Richmond Public School System. After high school he started working for Standard Furniture Company, where he remained employed for 10 years. Deacon Crawford later started a career with Supervalu (Richfood) as an order selector then moved up the corporate ladder to become a trucker driver. He served this company for 31 years and retired, February 2019 due to health challenges. After retirement, he still wanted to serve. He pressed forward obtaining employment with Bay Transit, as a driver,

serving the New Kent and Charles City community. He provided transportation for locals to/from work, medical appointments, etc.

Deacon Crawford was preceded in death by his father, Melvin E. Crawford, Sr. and brother Marvin E. Crawford. He leaves to cherish his memories, a devoted wife of 24 years, Joyce D. Crawford; four sons, Melvin E. Crawford III (Ariel), Antoney L.
