Melvin had a mild-mannered, non-judgmental personality. He would supply shelter to those who were homeless or money to those who were "down on their luck". He always saw the good qualities in a person. He was often questioned and cautioned about his decision to take a homeless stranger in his home; he would only reply "they'll be alright". Melvin was baptized as a youth at Mt. Zion United Methodist church. His Christian journey was evident in the life he lived.

Melvin made numerous friends wherever he went and will be sincerely missed by everyone who knew him. He leaves to mourn: his mother, Eleanor Peels;

two sisters, Deborah Jackson and Patricia Peels; brother, Carlos James; brother-in-law, Shephard Jackson; two daughters, Melissa and Chantaye Peels, ten grandchildren, a host of nieces and nephews.
